**\*What in the World? A global survey of CPS products, practices and policies (1 CEU Session) – Presenter Denise Donaldson**

*In this session, take a look at CPS in foreign countries and regions around the world. A sampling of laws, standards, and attitudes will be covered, as well as the types of car seat products that are used.*

**\*Developing a CPS Roll Call video for Law Enforcement - Presenter Merry Banks** *Participants will learn how to help law enforcement understand the intent of CPS laws and exemptions; spot gross misuse and learn proper note taking for successful court prosecution. A roll call video for officers was developed to enhance LE understanding of the CPS law.*

**\*Child Passenger Safety at the American Academy of Pediatrics (1 CEU session) – Presenter Rebecca Levin** *Ever wondered how the AAP develops policy statements relating to CPS, what is the current and upcoming policy recommendations from the AAP related to CPS and updates on other CPS activity at the AAP.*

**Child Passenger Safety in Rural California Tribal Communities – Presenter Barbara Hart** *This presentation is designed to provide the current trends for safety belt and child restraint use rate among the CA Indian Community. Tribal Sovereignty and its challenges will be discussed. Capacity building, passage of transportation laws and sharing of an Injury Prevention American Indian Toolkit will be presented*
